



The path to the most expensive contemporary art leads straight to Jack Armstrong, “The Last Wizard”, as his friend, Andy Warhol, nicknamed him. He worked with Warhol & Basquiat in New York City, from 1979 - 1987. After refusing a solo exhibition with Leo Castelli’s Gallery in 1984, he presented an anti-dealer ethos he would maintain throughout his artistic career. There are only 100 Cosmic ‘X’ Originals in the world. These works are collected by Billionaires & filled with a magical energy that is experienced by those who view the art in person.

There was a digital 2 year art ‘retrospective’ for Cosmic ‘X’ Art displayed on a giant screen in Times Square, NYC that ran 24 Hours a day from 2018-2020 so millions of people could experience Cosmic X. Cosmic ‘X’ was founded in 1999.
